

Purpose

- Improve safety and access for drivers and pedestrians
- Formalize elements of successful outdoor seating program
- Improve connectivity and quality of life for Claysburg Residents
- Fix failing streetscape elements in historic downtown
 - Tree wells
 - Sidewalks/curbs/ramps where necessary
